Medically Necessary

- I. Unilateral focused ultrasound thalamotomy is considered medically necessary for the treatment of adults with essential tremors when all of the following criteria are met:
- A. Moderate to severe tremor of the hand (as defined by a score of 2 or greater on the clinical rating scale for tremor [CRST]); and
- B. Failure of 2 or more tremor suppressant medications, as evidenced by persistent moderate to severe tremors, intolerable side effects of drug therapy or contraindications; and
- C. At least 1 of the medications failed was a first line agent (propranolol or primidone).
