



## Waived Co-payments

Co-payments for the diabetes-related prescription drugs and supplies listed below are waived for Face to Face Diabetes Program participants. **However, participants are responsible for their deductibles and 75% co-insurance of any non-preferred brand medication. In addition, some medications have an ancillary fee for which participants are responsible.** This waiver is for retail purchases only, mail order purchases are excluded. PEIA will pay 100% of PEIA's allowance for in-network services. Out-of-network services are processed at the out-of-network benefit level.
