Our mission is to help uninsured or underinsured women gain access to services that are critical to the early detection of breast and cervical cancers, including:

- Pap tests
- Pelvic exams
- Mammograms
- Clinical breast exams

Do you qualify?

To qualify, you must:

- Be a woman
- Be a West Virginia resident
- Have no insurance or be underinsured (high deductible or co-pays)
- Be between the ages of 25 and 64
- Meet the income guidelines listed on the chart below

For each additional family member add \$347 to monthly income. Income guidelines are updated annually. The guidelines above are valid from June 30, 2016 through June 29, 2017.

When found early, cancer is often easier to treat and your chance of survival greatly improves.

What if I have cancer?

The West Virginia Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Program will help guide you. Funding is available to assist qualified women who need diagnostic or treatment services.

Did you know?

- Breast cancer is the most commonly diagnosed cancer among women in West Virginia
- One in eight women will be diagnosed with breast cancer and one in 36 women will die from the disease
- Nearly all cases of invasive cervical cancer can be prevented with routine screening
- Nearly 12,000 women will be diagnosed with cervical cancer this year in the United States
